## CONCERT DAY INFORMATION

for String Orchestra, Sinfonia, Philharmonia and Symphony members

Concert day dress rehearsals are held at Rice University's Shepherd School of Music. Please note your orchestra's assigned times below. Attendance at the dress rehearsal is required.



To reach the Shepherd School, enter either Entrance 18 off of Rice Blvd. or Entrance 8 off of University Blvd. (Click [here](#) for a campus map.)

Arrive at least 20 minutes prior to your assigned time ready to rehearse! This is very important because we need to begin the concert on time.

Dress Rehearsal schedule is as follows:

Symphony	12:00 p.m.
Philharmonia	1:00 p.m.
Sinfonia	1:45 p.m.
String Orchestra	2:30 p.m.

Symphony, Philharmonia and Sinfonia members proceed to Hirsch Hall. Look on the walls for your orchestra's sign and put your belongings as close to the wall in that section as possible. String Orchestra members should proceed to Room 1401. Please put your belongings as close to the walls as possible.

**All orchestra members must come fully dressed to their rehearsal in their concert attire and must sign in with their orchestra manager upon arrival.** Members will be checked to make sure concert dress complies with the HYS Members' Handbook. If you forgot an item you will have to borrow whatever you need from another member to comply with dress code.

*Members, please do not bring valuables to the concert such as iPhones, laptops, etc. There is no one to watch over these things when you are performing.*

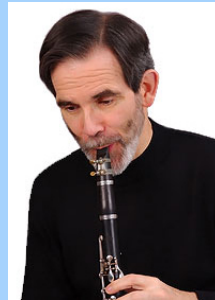
